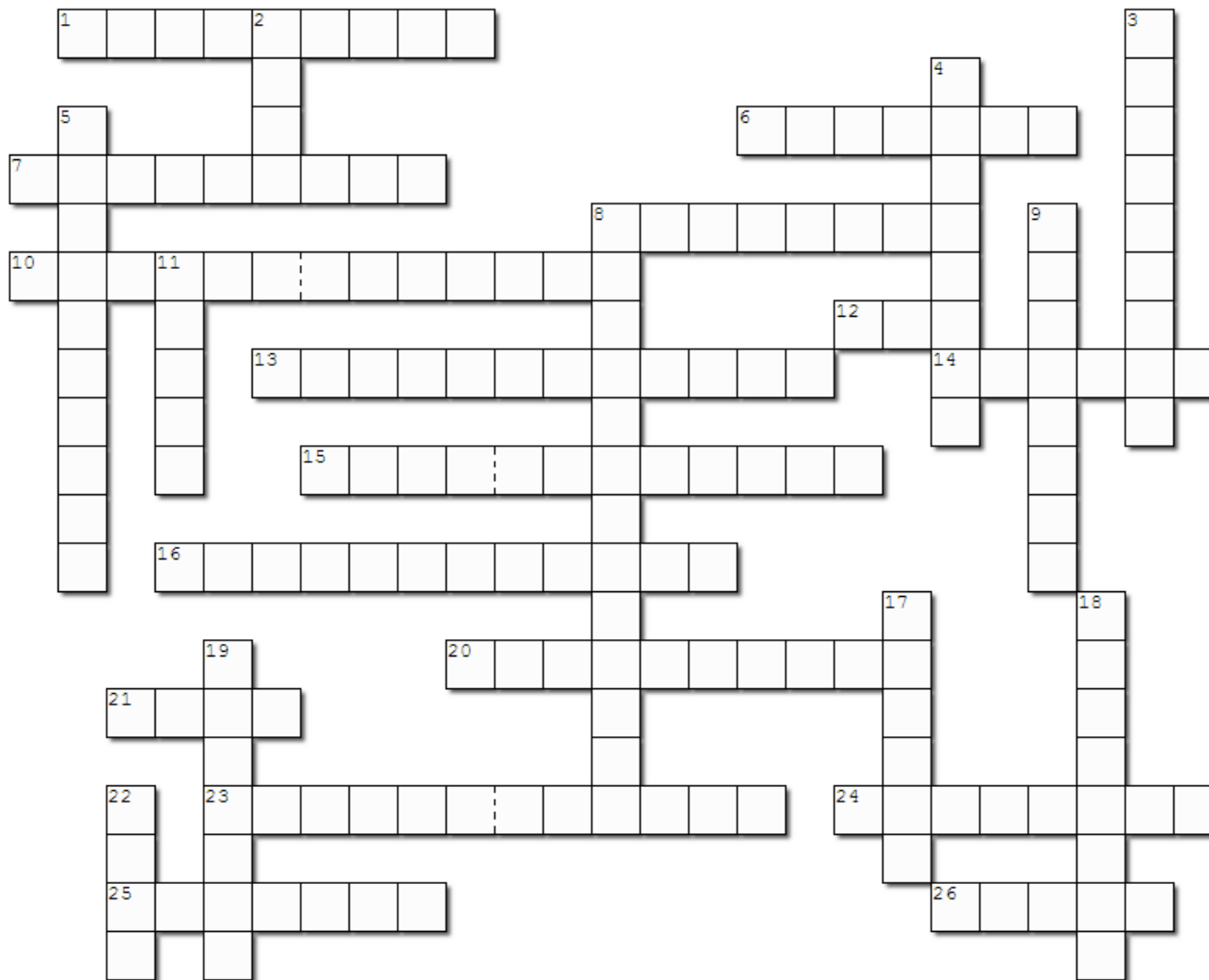


Language Day Crossword
