

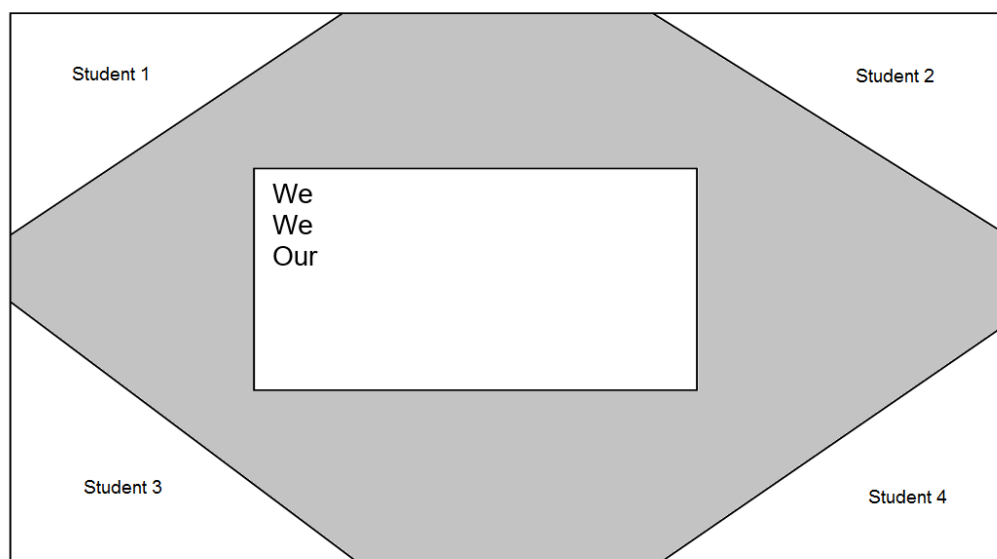
Getting to know... (Group work game)

Task 1

Teacher gives students A3 pieces of paper divided as in a picture below. There are four students in a team. They need to think about what they all have in common and write it in the square. Two sentences should begin with 'we' and one with 'our'. (e.g. *We all like pizza. We don't like pink.*)

Task 2

Every student has a triangle where s/he can put what makes him/her different from other members of the team. For example, Ivan has got a dog and other students haven't. There must be five sentences in each triangle and they should begin with some of the following: *I'm, I have got, I haven't got, I like, I don't like, My hobby is, My favourite sth is, I play / do* (sports, the chores). Students can also use *always / never / sometimes / rarely / often / every day*.



Task 3

The student who has done the least in a team will read 'the we sentences'. Every student has to read somebody else's triangle sentences. While reading, they need to make all the grammar changes of pronouns and most verbs (i.e. *Marko has got...*) Teacher notes the language errors and after the game is finished, s/he announces the winning team.
