We use the past simple to tell stories from the past that are not related to present time. e.g. Once upon a time there was a good king who ruled for forty years.

We use the past simple to say that one action followed another (for the order of events). e.g. He opened the door, took off his coat and started crying.

We use the following words and phrases in writing about the order of events in the past: Once upon a time, First, Then, After that, Finally, In the end, ...

We don't have to use the past simple when we quote somebody's exact words. e.g. ...and then he said: 'I'll call you soon'.
