
# **Musical shakers**







The giraffe is the tallest animal in the world. It has a long neck and long legs.


It has short hair. It can run fast, but it can't swim. It can live for 25 years. The giraffe's favourite food is leaves.

# Wood to pencil




### **1** Read and order. Match.

In the factory a machine cuts the wood. It puts the colours in the wood.


A lorry takes the pencils to shops.

Wood comes from trees. A lorry takes wood to a pencil factory.




#### 2 Make a pencil pot.

Stick a circle of card on the bottom of the tube.




Make a cone of yellow card.
