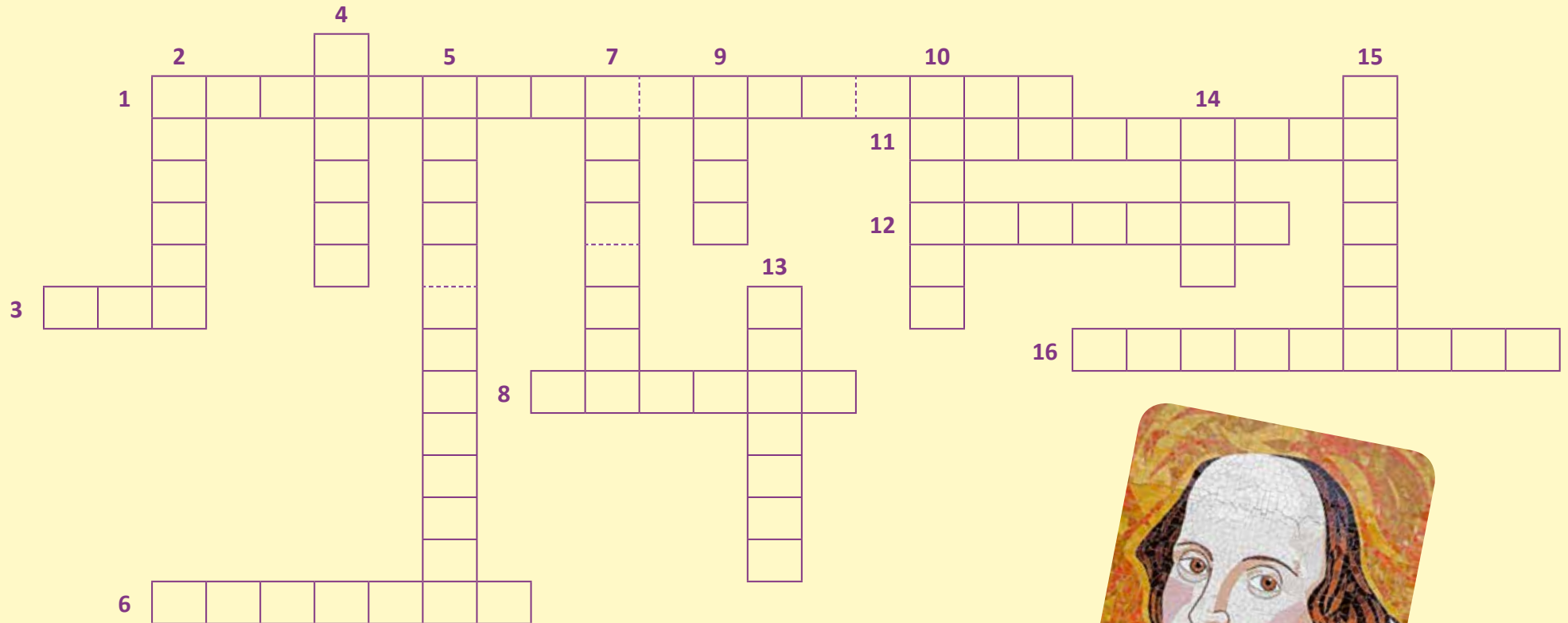




# SHAKESPEARE

## Did you know?

**William Shakespeare** [1564-1616] was born in Stratford-upon-Avon in England in 1564, during the reign of Queen Elizabeth I. He was a playwright, a poet and an actor, and is often considered the greatest British writer of all times. He wrote thirty-seven plays, 3 poems and 154 sonnets. Some of his most famous plays are *Hamlet*, *Othello*, *Macbeth* and *Romeo and Juliet*.
